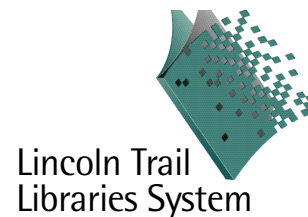

Area Librarians and Trustees Serve on Lincoln Trail Libraries System Board

The Board of Directors for Lincoln Trail Libraries System (LTLS) is in place for fiscal year 2007, which began on July 1, 2006.
