Spanish Resources Available from Lincoln Trail Libraries System

The growing Spanish-speaking population in East Central Illinois can now access information much easier because of a new resource, the Spanish version of Lincoln Trail's shared online catalog that lists the holdings of 105 member libraries. The Spanish version of the catalog is available at this Web site: <http://www.lincolntrail.info/ipac.html>. Once there, click on the link to "Lincoln Trail (Español)" at the top of the page. This will take you to a Spanish-language version of the catalog.

Besides the Spanish interface to the catalog, the libraries of Lincoln Trail Libraries System also own almost 5,000 books, dvd's, cd's, periodicals, and audiotapes in the Spanish language. This collection includes materials for adults and children and range from popular materials to bilingual publications.

Founded in 1966, Lincoln Trail Libraries System has headquarters in Champaign and is one of 9 multitype library systems in the State of Illinois. The System serves 7 academic, 53 public, 45 school, and 17 special libraries in Champaign, Clark, Coles, Douglas, Edgar, Ford, Iroquois, Piatt, and Vermilion counties. Lincoln Trail Libraries System connects the people of East Central Illinois to information through cooperation.
